Review. Textual evidence is information (details) from a text that support a statement you have made to show your understanding of the text. Textual evidence is required any time you draw a conclusion, make an inference, or make a prediction about a text to show WHY you think that way. In the 8th grade, you have to take this ONE step further and decide which piece of textual evidence most STRONGLY supports an idea from a text.
