Place in-text citations inside parenthesis and ensure that the citation is formatted correctly. If you use the name of the author from whom you borrowed the information in the sentence, as "Dr. Hopkins, the lead scientist at the University of Oceania's Biological Research Center, indicates that..." then the citation should only include the page number of the reference, as "(637)."

These are the places where citations are required. Identify the author's name and publication year for each reference you used to write your essay. Find the places in the essay where you named the author(s) from your reference material. Add the publication year of the reference in parenthesis immediately following the name(s) in your essay.

To format references in your paper, there is an Add-in for Microsoft Word 2016 for Windows and Mac. This is called RefWorks Citation Manager. Users of earlier versions of word will use a Plug-in called either Write-N-Cite or ProQuest for Word, which is available for download in their RefWorks account.

APA: Citing Within Your Paper | Ashford Writing Center

If you are using a direct quote, put the citation on the outside of the closing quotation mark. End punctuation (period, exclamation point) for the text follows the parenthetical citation. If you are using a block quotation, place the citation after the final punctuation mark of the paragraph.

Switch to the "References" tab on the Ribbon, and then click the "Insert Citation" button. The popup menu that appears shows any sources you have already added (we'll get to that in a moment), but to add a new source, just click the "Add New Source" command.

How To Automatically Add Citations And Bibliographies To ...

In-text citations for print sources with known author For print sources like books, magazines, scholarly journal articles, and newspapers, provide a signal word or phrase (usually the author's last name) and a page number. If you provide the signal word/phrase in the sentence, you do not need to include it in the parenthetical citation.

Place the in-text citation within the text of your paper after the information that the citation refers to.
