If $a < b$, then $a + c < b + c$. Adding the same number to each side of an inequality does not change the direction of the inequality symbol. If $a < b$, then $a - c < b - c$. Subtracting the same number from each side of an inequality does not change the direction of the inequality symbol. If $a < b$ and if c is a positive number, then $a \cdot c < b \cdot c$.
