Close-Up Photography vs Macro vs Micro (What's the Difference)

Macro photography is in essence close up photography as well. However, close up photography is not always considered as true macro photography. For example, if you have a lens that is NOT considered a real macro lens, yet offers a macro setting (as many do nowadays), this is usually referred to as being close up photography, and not true macro.

When you purchase a true macro lens that says it shoots 1:1, that means that when you get to the minimum focusing distance of the lens, it will reproduce the actual size of the subject you have framed, onto the sensor of the camera, or another term is reproducing the life size of the subject.
