Also, if the table or illustration's caption gives complete information about the source and the source isn't cited in the text, there is no need to include the citation in the works cited page. In the text of the project or paper, place a parentheses at the end of the line where the figure is discussed, and include the label.

MLA Format: Everything You Need to Know Here

If the author's name is unknown, alphabetize by the title, ignoring any A, An, or The. For dates, spell out the names of months in the text of your paper, but abbreviate them in the list of works cited, except for May, June, and July. Use either the day-month-year style (22 July 1999) or the month-day-year style (July 22, 1999) and be consistent.
