## **OECD releases Country-by-Country reporting XML Schema**

The OECD has released an XML Schema (v1.0.1), which is the approved form that must be used to lodge the CbC report. This schema enables the standardised exchange of CbC reports between jurisdictions. Note: The OECD has also released the XML Schema v2.0 applicable for reporting periods commencing on or after 1 January 2020.
