G Sec: NRI Investment in Government Securities in 2020. Since April 1st 2020, NRIs have been allowed to invest in specified GOI-dated securities without any quantitative limit with the government of India taking a decision to enable a "Fully Accessible Route (FAR)" as a separate channel for this purpose. The Central Bank also upped the limit for Foreign Portfolio Investment (FPI) in corporate bonds to 15% of outstanding stock for FY21 from 9%.
