Misplaced: The salesman tried to sell a car to a customer that was broken down. (Broken down is the modifier, but because it's closest to customer, it sounds like the customer is broken down instead of the car.) Corrected: The salesman tried to sell a broken-down car to a customer. Misplaced: Mrs. Harris hung the lovely student's drawing on the wall.

When you have a single adjective or adverb, misplaced modifiers rarely occur since they would immediately sound incorrect. However, when an entire phrase is used, misplaced modifiers become more common. Here are a few examples of phrases as modifiers: Scared he'd be late for class, Jake ran to school. Early in the morning, she rose to work.

MISPLACED MODIFIERS A misplaced modifier is a modifying word, phrase, or clause that does not point clearly and directly to what it is supposed to modify. Recognize and correct the following kinds of misplacement. Misplaced Word: He almost decided to eat half the pie for supper. Revised: He decided to eat almost half the pie for supper.
