The largest accidental oil spill in history began in the Gulf of Mexico on April 20, 2010, after a surge of natural gas blasted through a cement well cap that had recently been installed to seal a well drilled by the Deepwater Horizon oil platform. The gas traveled up the rig's riser to the platform, where it ignited, killing 11 workers and injuring 17.

A homeowner or resident who becomes aware of an oil spill on the property should report the spill or leak to the DEC Oil Spill Hotline within two hours (800-457-7362). If the discharge enters or threatens to enter the environment (such as soil or water), regardless of the size of the tank or the leak, the leak or spill is subject to state or federal oil spill laws.

## **Oil Pipelines and Spills - Climate, Energy, and Society ...**

Oil and Gas operators are required by §3.20, Chapter 3 (TAC) to give immediate notice of a fire, leak, spill, or break to the appropriate commission district office (see a map of the district boundaries here) by telephone. Such notice shall be followed by a letter submitted to the district office giving the full description of the event including, but not limited to, the volume of crude oil, gas, geothermal resources, other well liquids, or associated products that are lost.
