New Law Regarding the Use of Restraint and Seclusion for Students in California Assembly Bill (AB) 2657, Statutes of 2018, Chapter 998, will go into effect on January 1, 2019. The bill added sections 49005–49006.4 to California's Education Code regarding the use of restraint and seclusion with students receiving both general education and special education.

The Department of State Hospitals (DSH) deems the safety of both patients served and staff to be of paramount importance in our treatment settings. The use of seclusion and restraints has been a safety measure for dangerous and at-risk patients when other less restrictive interventions have failed. However, while maintaining a safe treatment setting, DSH seeks to continually and substantially minimize the use of seclusion and behavioral restraint in the state hospitals, and to prevent the ...

- Seclusion defined as involuntary confinement alone in a room or area from which they are prevented from leaving.

RESTRAINT AND SECLUSION IN CALIFORNIA: A LEGAL UPDATE

Restraint or seclusion may be imposed only to ensure the immediate physical safety of the patient, a staff member, or others and must be discontinued at the earliest possible time. The patient also has the right to safe implementation of restraint or seclusion by trained staff [42 C.F.R. Section 482.13(e) and (f)].

CHAPTER 5 RESTRAINT AND SECLUSION

Restraint and seclusion (R/S) are reactionary crisis or emergency responses. School personnel should only use R/S in extreme situations like when a student exhibits dangerous behaviors towards self or others, when a risk of serious and imminent physical harm or injury is evident.

Georgia law limits restraints to emergencies only and completely bans seclusion – the only state in America to do so. California, on the other hand, received a low score of 1. California's only regulation regarding restraints is that the school notify parents of disabled children in the event of restraint.

The Use of Restraints and Seclusion in California Schools ...

Pupil discipline: restraint and seclusion. Existing law prohibits a person employed by or engaged in a public school to inflict, or cause to be inflicted, corporal punishment upon a pupil. This bill would authorize an educational provider, as defined, to use behavioral restraints, which includes physical and mechanical restraints, or seclusion, as defined, only to control behavior that poses a clear and present danger of serious physical harm to the pupil or others that cannot be immediately ...

Bill Text - AB-2657 Pupil discipline: restraint and seclusion.

California's updated Education Code defines seclusion and certain types of restraints, which are to be used only when a student poses an immediate threat to his or her safety, or the safety of someone else. Mechanical restraint is defined as "the use of a device or equipment to restrict a pupil's freedom of movement.

(GSH Policy) RESTRAINT AND SECLUSION

Restraint and seclusion, as described in this article, do not further a child's education. At the same time, the Legislature recognizes that if an emergency situation arises, the ability of education personnel to act in that emergency to safeguard a pupil or others from imminent physical harm should not be restricted.
