At the beginning and end of each scale, finger numbers indicated in superscript or subscript should be used instead of finger numbers immediately following or preceding them. For example, the C scale begins with a 5 instead of a 1 in the left hand, and it ends with a 5 instead of a 1 in the right hand.

Scale & Arpeggio Fingerings for Piano Rules and tricks for remembering the fingerings for two octave scales and arpeggios on the piano. Major Scale Groups Group 1: C, G, D, A, E 3rd finger in each hand always plays together. Both thumbs play at the octave. Oddball: F F is like C, but the RH goes 1234 123 1234 1234. Group 2: D^b/C[#], G^b/F[#], B/C^b

Scale & Arpeggio Fingerings for Piano (2 Octave)

In a nutshell, the necessity of thumbs and pinkies on black notes presents itself when being asked to exceed a certain speed threshold on scales and arpeggios that don't start/end with thumb/pinky. For example, as uncomfortable as it feels, one can play a 2-octave D-flat arpeggio much faster with C major arpeggio fingering than with the standard D-flat arpeggio fingering.

General Arpeggio Fingering Rules. The fingering pattern repeats every three notes, so that every octave has the same fingering. The thumb always stays on the white keys, except when there are no white keys (F[#]/G^b major and D[#]/E^b minor). The fifth finger is only used at a starting place, a stopping place, or a turning-around place.

Major Scales, Arpeggios, and Cadences, 2 octaves

Arpeggios include major and minor varieties, shown side by side to each other. Arpeggios ascend and descend three octaves. Arpeggios include all keys, beginning at C major, followed by G major, D major, etc until F sharp major, then switches over to D flat major, and descends in flats until F major.

This pattern of whole and half steps is what creates the sound of major. The 12 minor scales, however, come in 3 variations The Harmonic minor scale uses the same keys as the parallel major scale (same starting note, but major), but lowers the 3rd and the 6th.; The Melodic minor scale uses the same keys as the parallel major scale, but lowers the 3rd when ascending (going up) and lowers ...

Practice really needs time. Start playing slowly and strive for accuracy. Only when you've succeeded in playing exactly and evenly all the notes of a scale you should start increasing speed.

arpeggios - Color In My Piano

When a scale or arpeggio is played at the highest standard it is entirely even in all three. The pitch is even – the same letter-names in the different octaves are in tune with each other, with a consistent logic behind the tuning of each note. The sound is even – undisturbed by changes of string, bow, position or finger.
