The definition of synchronicity was originally developed by Swiss psychologist Carl Gustav Jung. Jung co-defined the word to describe what he called "temporally coincident occurrences of acausal events.". Jung variously described synchronicity as an "acausal connecting principle" (i.e., a pattern of connection that cannot be explained by conventional, efficient causality), "meaningful coincidence" and "acausal parallelism".
