The Zone System requires a spot meter and full manual exposure mode. While a handheld spot meter is preferable, you can make do with your camera's built-in spot meter mode. If you're using the camera's spot mode, try metering with a telephoto lens to narrow the metering coverage appropriately.

It would have been a little above the 11 on the bottom scale. The red triangle, shows that exposure could have been f5.6 @ 8th or f11 @ 1/2 sec. The dial below, shows the Ansel Adams Zone dial which was an accessory. For the Zone system the red triangle in the upper picture is indicative of Zone 5.
